Children with special needs, who are waiting for sponsor

Ni Luh Ayu

Ni Luh Ayu is a Cerebral Polcy. She comes from a very poor family and is homeless. With support from the people around him the family has been able to rent a small room close to the Yayasan .
Because of the condition of Iluh Ayu, her mother hasto stay at home continuously to take care of Iluh Ayu. Her father has no education, and has no steady job. If he can find work, the wages are often not enough to his family with 3 children. .

Iluh Mahini

Below is the story of Iluh Mahini's father,

I Luh is my daughter and she is Autistic. My wife passed away a few years ago. Having an autistic child is very difficult for me because she is hyperactive and I cannot spend all of my time to take care of her because I have to work to support my family.
I don't have someone to take care of Iluh, I always take Iluh to the place where I work though most of the time she disturbs me in working, but I have no other option. I cannot send her to the Special School, for I feel worried, because Iluh is so hyperactive and the special School can not give enough attention to her, because they have so many children. Besides that my financial situation makes it impossible to send Iluh to the Special School.
I feel very happy to see the progress of Iluh since she study in the Yayasan Widya Guna, she is very happy.

Dela

Below is the story of the mother of Dela,

Dela is accepted in Special School but I feel worried to leave Dela at School without us accompanying her because the children there are not careful, and Dela is not able to protect herself. Dela still attending the public special School but ony when I have money for the transport fee. And only when I don't have to work. My husband is a wood carver and I sell his work. That is our income and from that we continue our life. Our children are all still attending School so we have to work hard for them to continue their school. Most of time, we sent Dela to Yayasan Widya Guna for study, social interaction and I feel save to leave her there.
Dela also has many friends there and she is always very happy to be there.
